Board of Education agendas are publicly posted at the District Office, at each school in session, and on our website.

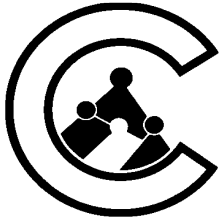
Individuals needing special accommodations should contact the Superintendent's Office in writing at least one week prior to the meeting date.

The Board may choose to respond to agenda item comments or reserve their responses for discussion and action when the agenda item appears during the course of the meeting. It should be noted that the Board discourages complaints against individual officers or employees of the District during open session.
